Sonoran Desert Institute Tuition Protection Agreement

We believe that you will find your chosen program to be everything we claim. To assure you of this, we provide you with this liberal *Tuition Protection Agreement*. You may request cancellation in any manner, but written request is recommended. Tuition refunds will be based on the date you cancel and the point at which you are in the program/course of study, as follows:

- 1) You may cancel this Enrollment Agreement and receive a full refund of all monies paid to date if cancellation is made within five (5) business days [excluding Saturday, Sunday and state and federal holidays] after date of signature (the "Cancellation Period").
- 2) If you cancel after the Cancellation Period, you will be charged a registration fee of 20% of the program/course tuition or \$200, whichever is less. All other monies will be refunded. All refunds will be paid within 30 days of receipt of the request.
- 3) If you cancel after the Cancellation Period, your financial obligation will be a registration fee (see #2 above) and part of the tuition* based on a four (4) week semester as follows:

1st week	=	70%
2nd week	=	40%
3rd week	=	20%
4th week	=	0%

*Refundable tuition is the total course tuition minus the registration fee.

- 4) If you complete more than four (4) weeks of the program/course and its content or assignments, you are obligated for the full tuition cost of the program.
